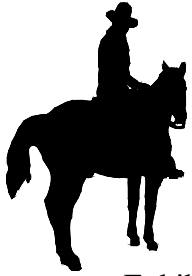

GENERAL RULES

1. Current Negative Coggins is required for all horses showing or entering the Warren County Fairgrounds for any event. Coggins are to be presented in order to ride. No stallions allowed on grounds.
2. All horses will be properly controlled at all times, both in and out of the arena and will not be ridden to the endangerment of anyone and should be properly trained for the classes. Any unsportsman like conduct or mistreatment of any animal will result in disqualification and forfeiture of all entries and will be asked to leave the fairground. All horses must stay in designated area. The owners or parents of participant must hold any game horse that has to be held.
3. All 4-H and FFA youths must have attended ½ of the project meetings in order to show. All members must have a parent or guardian remain present on grounds at all times. Parent or guardian are responsible for their children, horses' and equipment.
4. Show is open to Warren County 4-H and FFA members in good standings with their association. Age of Rider is as of January 1, current year. Parents and Trainers are asked to avoid schooling of exhibitors and horses (This is a YOUTH SHOW). All members must show their project horse.
5. Proper attire is required for ALL classes (*This includes anyone in the arena-assistants and judges*). Boots must be worn in all classes (NO tennis shoes), western shirt with collar, and hat or safety helmets and equipment can be used at your parents or guardians discretion (NO ball caps). Approved safety helmets must be worn in all speed and game classes. Exhibitor's number must be placed on exhibitors back while in the show ring, not on saddle blankets.
6. At the shows a two-minute gate will be in effect per class after class has entered arena. PLEASE BE READY ON TIME.
7. Any exhibitor entering a walk trot game class are allowed to enter **only** walk trot game class.
8. All members are required to ride the same horse in all events. Two exhibitors can use the same horse only if enrolled as a 4-H or FFA project horse, **BUT is only allowed one entry per class**. All exhibitors are allowed to enter one class per event. All members will participate with Showmanship at Halter and Western Horsemanship, in order to participate in the game classes. Project horse must be under your management by May 1, 2009.
9. At the shows a 5 second penalty for each overturned barrel in the barrel race, and each overturned pole in the pole bending, No time given for broken pattern in all games or if flag is dropped in flag race. No reins, whips, romels, or bats to be used in any class.
10. Showmanship at Halter and Western Horsemanship classes will be judged on the Danish system. All game classes will have top five placing. Premiums will be paid on Showmanship at Halter events. You must be at clean up of the fair on Sunday after the fair to pick up your premium.
11. All classes are subject to change depending on ability of horse & rider, entry and length of show. Entries will be limited per class.
12. All disputes will need to be brought before the "show committee" and a decision will be made.
